

The following rules shall apply at all events at which alcohol will be served:

1. The person identified as responsible for compliance with the alcohol policy (the "Responsible Person") must see to it that these rules are adhered to. The Responsible Person must attend the entire event.
2. NO PERSON SHALL BE SERVED ALCOHOL UNDER THE AGE OF 21.
3. No person shall be served alcohol if he or she is intoxicated in the reasonable judgment of the bartender, wait person, or the Responsible Person.
4. All bar service shall be provided by Georgia Southern University Catering, using bartenders trained in the safe and responsible service of alcohol except in the case of Paulson Stadium boxes.
5. Appropriate amounts of non-alcoholic beverages and food shall be provided.
6. No announcement, publicity, or other materials concerning the event, whether printed, broadcast, or placed on the Internet, shall promote the amount of consumption, the frequency of consumption of alcoholic beverages at the event.
7. No alcoholic beverages will be sold at any event, either directly or through the use of tickets or tokens. This does not preclude the sale of tickets for admission to such an event; however such tickets shall not be sold at the door. This also does not preclude the use of tickets or tokens as a means of controlling consumption.
8. No kegs are permitted on campus under any circumstances.
9. Alcohol consumption shall be restricted to the area reserved for the event.
10. All costs of the event, including but not limited to bartenders, wristbands, and security, shall be borne by the individual or organization sponsoring the event.
11. Appropriate security should be provided for events, with the number of officers present determined by the appropriate Vice President. The Vice President may make a determination that the event does not require security.
12. If persons under the age of 21 are expected to attend the event, the Responsible Person must ensure that those persons will not be served alcoholic beverages under any circumstances. **No person shall be served alcohol at such an event until he or she has provided picture**

identification proving that he or she is over the age of 21. The Responsible Person and the appropriate Vice President should employ wristbands or other means that will prevent underage consumption.
